We will run Best Open, then Absolute.

Judges for BO and ABS will be chosen at the time on site.

Ribbons and Prizes

The Dachshund Fanciers of SW WA offer: rosettes for all placements and all classes.

“New Title” rosettes will be given to any dog that completes the requirements for AKC Field Champion title while at our trial.

Compliance with all AKC and polite society’s rules is expected.

Eligibility of Dogs Competing

AKC registered Dachshunds that are intact, spayed or neutered or have a Limited Registration may participate. Dachshunds with ILP or PAL numbers are not eligible for this competition. Only dogs and bitches 6 months and older may compete.

Make sure your entry forms are complete and legible.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Test Secretary shall add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Bitches in season are eligible for entry in OAAB but are not eligible for entry into any combined sex stake.

Tracking Collar Policy

The host club will allow dachshunds to wear tracking collars at these field trials. The collar surface against the dog’s neck shall be flat (no protrusions). While the dachshunds are under judgement, handheld devices must be turned off. Handheld devices may be turned on only after the dachshund has been eliminated from competition by the judges or judgement has ceased. Procedure 3D of the AKC “Field Trial Rules and Procedures for Dachshunds” is still in effect (page 19).

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From the South: I-5 to Exit #48 (Business Loop/Castle Rock)

Left off ramp onto Huntington, travel west into Castle Rock, left turn at 4-way blinking light onto “A”. Go over bridge and take immediate left on Fair Lane

From the North: I-5 to Exit #49 (Castle Rock)

Right off ramp onto Huntington, travel west into Castle Rock, right turn at 4-way blinking light onto “A”. Go over bridge and make immediate left on Fair Lane
